

Student Parking Orientation Spring Semester 2025

Introduction

- Parking on school property is a privilege and not a right.
- There are limited parking spaces.
- Students must obey all traffic patterns and laws. This includes driving at appropriate speeds.
- Each high school principal determines the number of spaces on school premises that are designated for students, the procedure for allocating the spaces and the policies governing parking in alignment with AACPS Code of Student Conduct. <u>AACPS Policy JGA: Student</u> <u>Parking at High School and AACPS REgulation JGA-RA (906.01):</u> <u>Student Parking at High School.</u>

Rules & Responsibilities

- Students must display their parking tag. Students need to communicate to Mr. Love or Mrs. Dillon if there is an issue with their parking hang tag on any given day. Students are not to lend to or swap their pass with anyone. Students are not to be in possession of a parking pass that is not assigned to them. Students and parents should know that student's vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense if rules are not adhered to.
- Students will not linger at their cars or in the parking lot. Students are to park and promptly enter the building.
- Students must drive responsibly on school property.
- Students are responsible for their car and its contents while on school property.



Expectation of Students

- Must provide verifiable documentation.
- Must drive only the registered vehicle(s).
- Must remain in school during their scheduled day. Students need administrative approval to go to their car.
- Students may NOT leave school w/o permission.
- South River HS Students: You <u>MAY NOT</u> leave SRHS during NEST or lunch. (Closed campus – AKA do not leave campus)
- Must arrive to school on time!!
- Any student who leaves campus without permission, or is continuously tardy to school, is subject to administrative discipline and revoking of parking pass.

Violations

Any violations of the rules and regulations set by the school and AACPS my result in the following progressive disciplinary action:

1st Offense - Warning & Parent/Guardian Contact 2nd Offense - Dentation & Parent/Guardian Contact

3rd Offense - 1 week suspension of pass & Parent/Guardian Contact

4th Offense - Parking pass is revoked & Parent/Guardian Contact



Tardy Policy

Any violations of the rules and regulations set by the school and AACPS my result in the following progressive disciplinary action:

- **1st Offense First Warning**
- 2nd Offense Second Warning
- **3rd Offense Third Warning & Parent/Guardian Contact**
- **4th Offense Detention & Parent/Guardian Contact**
- 5th Offense 1 week suspension of parking pass & Parent/Guardian Contact
- 6th Offense Parking Pass is revoked & Parent/Guardian Contact



What do I do if someone parks in my spot?

- 1. Park in Visitor Parking
- 2. Please take a picture of the vehicle (license plate #, make, model, color) and report immediately to Mrs. Dillon in the main office.



Qualifications for Senior Parking

- Must be a senior and have earned 18 credits
- Must have a minimum cumulative, unweighted, GPA of 2.0
- Must have no student obligations
- Must have a valid driver's license and insurance
- Must have access to a car on a regular basis
- Must have a parking permit from your home school (except South River students)
- Seniors in work/internship programs



Qualifications for Junior Parking

Junior parking will not be available until the end of Semester after all seniors have been assigned parking.

- Must be a junior and have earned 13 credits
- Must have a minimum cumulative, unweighted, GPA of 2.0
- Must have no student obligations
- Must have a valid driver's license and insurance
- Must have access to a car on a regular basis
- Must have a parking permit from your home school (except South River students)
